



In the Shade of the Tree

One of the world's most celebrated photographers of rock music performers has launched a collection of work showcasing the diversity and beauty of the Islamic world. A new addition of Peter Sanders' *In the Shade of the Tree*, a photo-documentary of the author's travels around the Muslim world is now available. The book illustrates Sanders four decades of travels to experience the wonders of the Islamic world.



Peter Sanders began his career in the 1960's as one of London's leading photographers of rock musicians. His pictures of Bob Dylan, Jimi Hendrix, The Doors, The Rolling Stones, The Who and many others, are considered classics of the genre. In the late 1960's Sanders embarked on a spiritual journey that would take him to India, North Africa and then in 1971, to the Holy City of Makkah where he photographed the Hajj at a time when few professional photographers had access to Islam's holiest Sanctuary. Having travelled far and wide, Peter Sanders has built up an archive of photographs that are in great demand from publishers and media houses around the world. *In the Shade of the Tree* is a small selection from this rich collection of spiritual images.
